COLLEGE UNIFORM:

Uniforms are available in the college It is compulsory for every student to enter in the college in uniform.

Government Scholarship (for the college student)

Important suggestions-

The Director of Social Welfare Department provides the scholarship to S.C., S.T, N.T. and O.B.C student for the education after S.S.C. exam.

SCHOLARSHIP SHALL NOT BE GIVEN TO THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS:

- 1) Scholarship shall not be given to the student completing one commercial course.
- 2) Scholarship shall not be given to seminar course again.
- 3) Scholarship shall not be given to the student doing fulltime job.
- 4) Scholarship can be only two children of a guardian, excluding given girls students.

PROCEDURE OF FILLING IN SCHORLSHIP FORM:

Student must fill in scholarship form themselves. The form must be completed details. Student shall be disqualified who provide incomplete or fake information. It is necessary to provide gap certificate, if there is any discontinuation in education of B.A.I & B.Com. I student must fill in fresh application. It is not necessary for the schedule castes, nomadic tribes to pay academic tuition fee. Those students, whose scholarship forms are rejected, shall have to pay full academic tuition fee.

Essential instructions to the guardians of children having within 15000Rs income for fee facility:

- 1. The student's guardian how have income within 15000Rs can get EBC in specific clause on the basis of income certificate.
- 2. The student whose age is below 18 years the form must be filled in by father or mother. It is necessary to fill the form by the signature of the guardian whose name is written on the form. If the father or mother is not alive, the form be filled in by guardians signature will be rejected.
- 3. The scholarship application form must be submitted within 30 days from getting admission in the college with two copies. The application form thereafter shall not be accepted.
- 4. The student of B.A.I and B.Com Ist or IInd year taking admission to the next class must submit the form within 30 days from the commencement of session.
- 5. The village of which population is within 10,000 such village will be considered as rural area. The student belonging to rural areas, must have signature of grampanchayat Sarpanch Gazetted officer. Necessary vice-sarpanch signature will not be accepted.
- 6. The student belonging to urban areas must have signature on income certificate of Gazette officer or non-residential Magistrate or Justice Officer attached in the fees concession form.
- 7. 75% attendances is necessary for fees concession otherwise the facility will be denied.
- 8. Student and his guardian shall be responsible if the information is found incorrect.

- 9. The discontinuation after passing S.S.C or any other eligible qualification after taking admission to the next class more than one year such student shall have to give court affidavit of other education with the concession form invariably.
- 10. There will be concession for the students having within 1500 Rs annual income. They will have to pay remaining charges.
