The aims and objectives for which the society is established are as under

- 1. To promote and foster mutually beneficial relationship between the Alumni and the present students of the college and between the Alumni themselves.
- 2. To provide the forum to establish a link between the alumni, staff, and students of the Institute.
- 3. To encourage the Alumni to take an active and abiding interest in the work and progress of the Institute.
- 4. To enable the alumni to participate in activities which would contribute to the general development of the institute.
- 5. To organize and establish scholarship funds to help the needy and deserving students.
- 6. To raise funds for various welfare and other schemes in the college as approved by the Association.
- 7. To institute prizes and awards for outstanding project work, research papers or other professional activity by the student of the Institute; also to suitably recognize outstanding social and community service by the Alumni and the Students.
- 8. To provide a forum for the alumni for exchange of ideas on academic, cultural and social issues of the day.
- 9. To arrange social and cultural functions.
- 10. To perform all other acts in furtherance of the objectives of the Association.
- 11. To assist in placement and internships to provide future employment and grooming opportunities for students.
- 12. To provide a forum for the alumni for interaction with the Management of the Institution so as to draw upon the knowledge and expertise of Alumni Association as a leading centre of Excellence in the field of education.
- 13. To establish, maintain, control and manage chapters of the Alumni Association as a means to increase participation of Alumni and to preserve and promote the interest of the Alma Mater through Alumni involvement in its future and governance.
