Agenda - 11

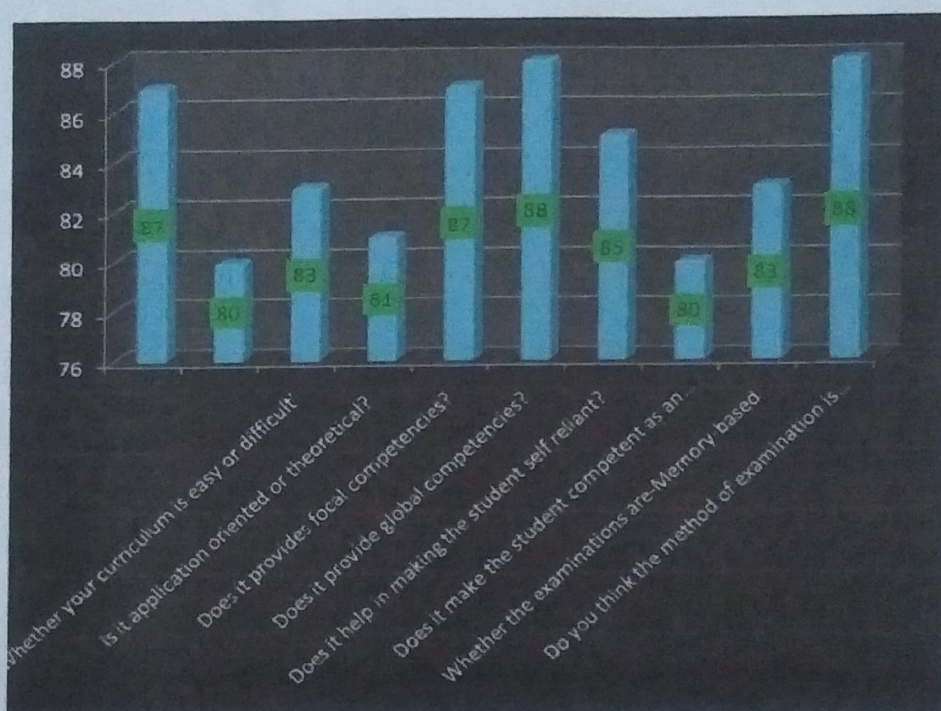
The IQAC approved the AQAR-2020-21 unanimously.

ANALYSIS OF STUDENT'S FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

2021-2022

The college has obtained feedback on curriculum from students through questionnaire. There were 10 questions in the Feedback Form. Collection of forms has been done on random sample basis from students of all the programmes. The analysis of the feedback forms is given below:

According to the analysis following major points have been noticed:

- It is analyzed that 85% of the students found curriculum relevant in the present scenario.
- 86% of the students found it apt and appropriate.
- For the 85% of the students, the syllabus was Easy. 15% of the students suggested to simplify it by making some positive changes.
- 88% of the students found the syllabus application-oriented.

- Nearly 80% of students found the curriculum matching to the local and global competencies.
- The All the students found the curriculum helpful in making the students self-reliant and competent as an entrepreneur.

Suggestions:

- Taking into consideration the background of the student difficulty level of the curriculum should be decided.
- Curriculum should be more job-oriented to suit to the needs of the changing world.
- Evaluation technique should be more efficient to evaluate the students at college and university level

Suggestions given by the Students were discussed in the IQAC meeting.

FEED BACK OF TEACHERS ON CURRICULUM

2021-2022

There were 10 questions in the feedback form. Collection of feedback forms has been done from teachers of Arts, Commerce Faculty. According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed:


- Most of the teachers have no direct role to play in the formation of syllabus as the college adheres to the curriculum framed by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. Teachers convey their suggestions to the Board of Studies members in the college.
- Nearly 92 % of the teachers found the syllabus adequate.
- 78% of the teachers were in favour of Interdisciplinary aspects of curriculum but 22% thought it would create confusion among students if not properly implemented.
- Most of the teachers found a need to make the curriculum more Job oriented.
- More than 82% of the teachers thought the curriculum helpful in overall development of the students.
- 65% of the teachers were of the view that the curriculum is conducive for professional growth of the students.


Suggestions:

- Teachers suggested framing of syllabus, considering the level and the background of the students.
- Most of the teachers advised the introduction of Semester Pattern.
- There should be a gradual development in the difficulty level of the syllabus.

IQAC discussed the suggestions given by the teachers in the meeting and




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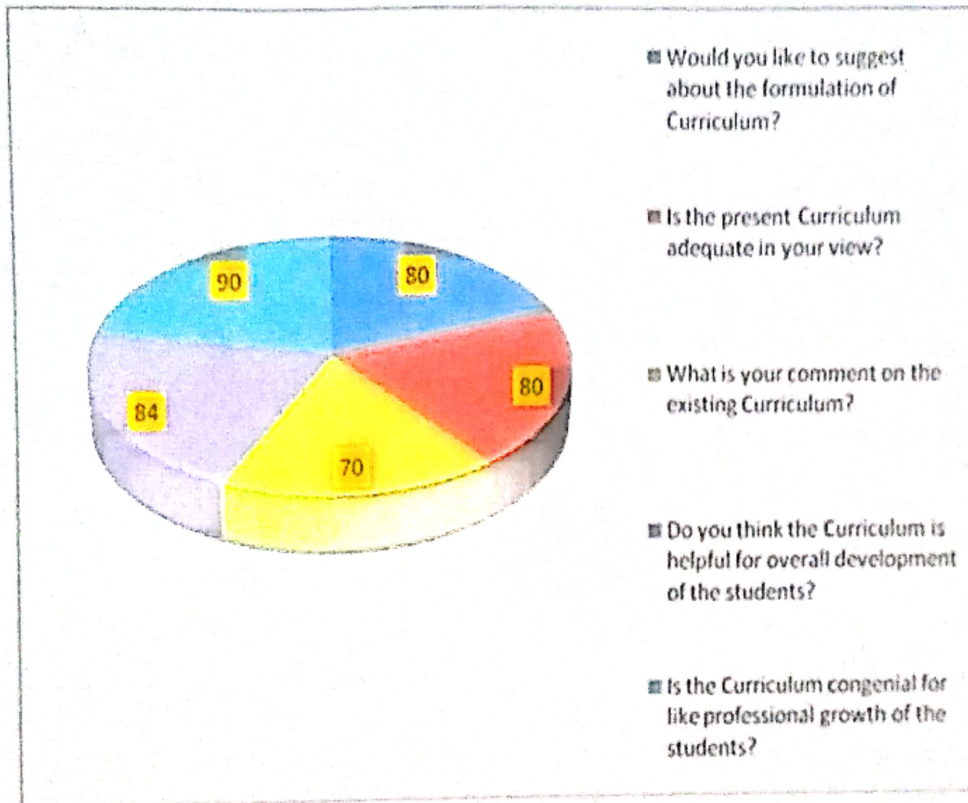


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FEED BACK OF PARENTS ON CURRICULUM

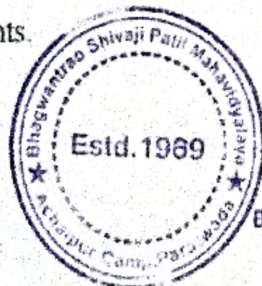

There were 5 questions in the feedback form for the parents. The Feedback form were collected from 50 Parents Form were collected at the time of Parents' Meet.



According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed:

- Nearly 80% of the parents were satisfied with the formulation of syllabus.
- 84% of the parents found it adequate.
- Most of the parents stressed a need of proper implementation of syllabus in the classrooms.
- 84% of the parents found syllabus helpful for the overall development of the students.



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- 90% of the parents found curriculum Conducive for professional growth.

Suggestions:

- Parents suggested a gradual development in the difficulty level of the syllabus.
- Parents showed their concern about the Semester Pattern to be introduced in the University.

IQAC discussed the suggestions given by the Parents in the meeting



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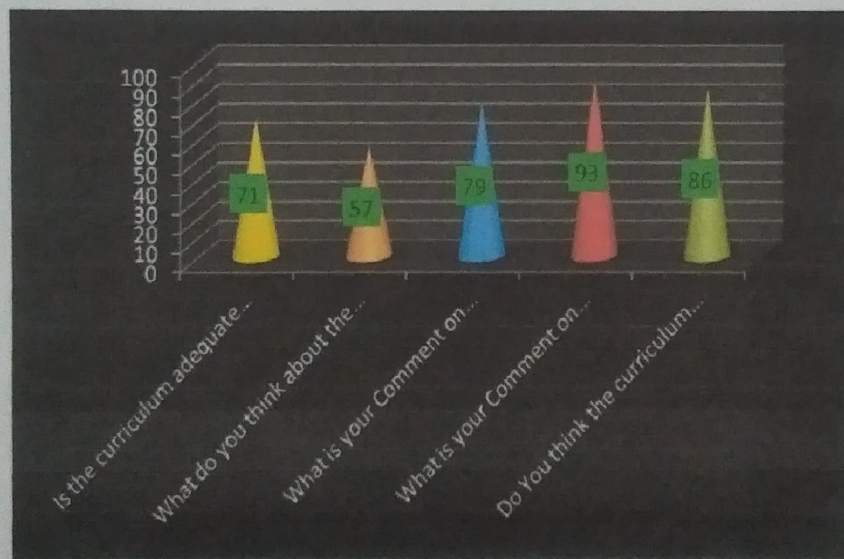

2021-2022

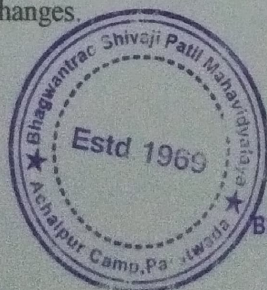
The Feedback Form for Alumni on Curriculum contained 5 questions. Feedback was taken from 60 alumni. The form were collected at the time of Alumni Meet.

According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed.

- The curriculum was found adequate by more than 83% of the alumni.
- Interdisciplinary aspects of the curriculum were welcomed by 58% of the alumni.
- Most of the alumni were satisfied with the existing curriculum and suggested some positive changes.



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- Nearly 83% of the alumni found the curriculum helpful for overall development of the student.
- Alumni were divided over the congeniality of the syllabus for the professional growth.


Suggestions:
